

# Command 2: Be Baptized

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## 1. Look Back (20 min)

### **Worship**

- Is there something you/we can thank God for?
- Worship (sing, pray, take communion, give, or reading scripture)

### **Loving Accountability**

Follow

- "Talk about how you obeyed Jesus command to repent and believe this past week."

Fish

- "Talk about how sharing your testimony and 3 circles went this past week"
- "Did anyone start meeting with people to start training or the Commands of Christ?"
- "How are your disciples doing sharing their testimony and 3 circles?"

### **Vision**

- Imagine the impact we could make on this campus. We could help thousands of students experience a relationship with Jesus. There will be students who have been enslaved to their desires who find freedom in Jesus. There will be students who have lived hollow empty lives who will find purpose in Jesus. There will be students who aren't loved by their family or classmates who in Jesus will experience an unending love. We can help 40,000 students who are longing for life change.

## 2. Look Up (30 min)

### **Lesson**

- Read the story: Philip and the Ethiopian official Acts 8:26-40
- "Retell the passage in your own words."
- "What does the passage teach us about God?"
- "What does the story teach us about people?"
- "Have you obeyed Jesus' command to be baptized?"
- "Who can you share with what you learned?"

### 3. Look Forward (20 min)

#### **Set Goals**

- C.O.S.T.
- C: When will you connect with Jesus?
- O: How will you obey Jesus?
- S: With whom will you share your story and God's story?
- T: Who can you train?

#### **Pray**

- Lay hands on each other and pray to live sent
- Love God, love people, make disciples
- Jesus, nothing more, nothing less
- Boldness to share our testimony and the gospel with people far from God
- Multiply generations of disciple-makers
